HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics (July – Sept., 2010)

In the third quarter of 2010, were reported 11 cases of HIV infections, being 7 males and 4 females. Of the newly HIV cases reported in this quarter, 4 of them were local residents and 7 were non-residents; 3 acquired the infection through heterosexual contact, 1 through homosexual, 2 by sharing the needles in drug injection, and in the other 5 cases the way of transmission was indeterminate due to insufficient information. In this quarter was also reported 1 AIDS case. (table 1)

Cumulatively, since 1986 up to the end of Sept. 2010, a total of 449 HIV infections were reported in Macao, being 48.6% diagnosed in temporary residents working in the entertainment industry; 54 of HIV infected patients have progressed to AIDS. The major route of transmission has been sexual, which constituted 66.8%, corresponding 58.4% to the heterosexual transmission and 8.2% to the homosexual transmission. The injecting drug use represented 13.6% of the infections. (table 1)
