HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics (Oct. – Dec., 2011)

In the fourth quarter of 2011, were reported 5 HIV infections, being 4 males and 1 female.

Among the new cases infected in this quarter, 2 occurred among local residents (1 acquired through injecting drug use, and in 1 case the way of transmission was indeterminate due to insufficient information). The other 3 were detected in non-resident individuals (1 acquired the infection through injecting drug use, and 2 of which acquired via heterosexual contact). In this quarter was also reported one AIDS case. (table 1)

In the year of 2011, a total of 21 infections were reported in Macao, representing a decrease of 22% in comparison with the year of 2010, and the rate of infection in local residents was 48%. Sexual contact is the principal route of transmission, representing 52%, and the transmission of HIV infection through injecting drug use accounted for 19% of the HIV infections. (table 2)

Cumulatively, since 1986 up to the end of December 2011, a total of 475 HIV infections was reported in Macao, being 47% diagnosed in temporary residents working in the entertainment industry; 60 of HIV infected patients have progressed to AIDS. The major route of transmission has been sexual (66%), corresponding 58% to the heterosexual transmission and 8% to the homosexual transmission. The injecting drug use represented 14% of the infections accumulated. (table 1)
