HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics (Oct. - Dec., 2008)

In the fourth quarter of 2008, were reported 10 HIV infections, being males and females half and half. Six infections occurred among local residents, 2 in non-resident individuals and the other 2 cases were detected in a temporary resident working in the entertainment industry.

Among the 6 local residents, 2 acquired the infection through heterosexual contact, 1 through homosexual contact, 2 through injecting drug use and in 1 case the route of transmission was indeterminate due to insufficient information.

Concerning the other 4 cases, 2 were detected in non-resident individuals, in which the route of HIV transmission was also indeterminate owing to inadequate information, and 2 cases occurred in a temporary resident working in the entertainment

industry that acquired the infection through heterosexual contact. (table 1)

In the year of 2008, a total of 22 infections were reported in Macao, representing an increase of 4.76% in comparison with the preceding year, and the rate of infection in local residents was 54.5%. The principal route of HIV transmission in Macao has been through sexual contact, especially heterosexual (50% of total cases), and 9.1% via homosexual. The transmission of HIV infection through injecting drug use accounted for 13.6% of the cases detected during 2008, registering an increase of 9.5% when for 13.6% of the cases detected during 2008, registering an increase of 9.5% when comparing with previous year. (table 2)

Cumulatively, since 1986 up to the end of December 2008, a total of 410 HIV

infections were reported in Macao, being 51.7% diagnosed in temporary residents working in the entertainment industry; 42 of HIV infected patients have progressed to AIDS. The major route of transmission has been sexual (67.6%), corresponding 59.8% to the heterosexual transmission and 7.8% to the homosexual transmission.

The injecting drug use represented 13.4% of the infections. (table 1)
