

HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO

Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics (Oct. – Dec., 2013)

In the fourth quarter of 2013, there were reported 5 cases of HIV infections, being all of them were males and local residents. 2 cases of the infections acquired the virus through heterosexual contact, 3 through homosexual contact.

In the year of 2013, a total of 28 HIV infections were reported in Macao, representing a decrease of 15% in comparison with the year of 2012, and the rate of infection in local residents was 61%. Sexual contact is the principal route of transmission, 46% accounted for the infection through heterosexual contact, 21% through homosexual contact, 4% through bisexual contact, and the injecting drug use represented 7% of the cumulative total.
