

HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO
Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics
(Jan – Mar., 2014)

In the first quarter of 2014, there were reported 11 cases of HIV infections, 7 of which were males and 4 were females.

Of the newly cases reported in this quarter, 7 were local residents and 4 were non-residents. In local residents, 4 cases of HIV infections acquired the virus through heterosexual contact, 2 through homosexual contact, and 1 through bisexual contact. In non-residents, 1 acquired the virus through heterosexual contact, 1 was an intravenous drug user, and in 2 cases the way of transmission was indeterminate due to insufficient information. During this quarter, 4 cases of AIDS were also declared.
