

HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO

Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics (Apr. – June, 2014)

In the second quarter of 2014, there were reported 10 cases of HIV infections, 8 of which were males and 2 were females.

Local residents and non-residents occupied half and half of the newly cases reported in this quarter. In local residents, 2 cases of HIV infections acquired the virus through heterosexual contact, 2 cases through homosexual contact, and 1 case was an intravenous drug user. In non-residents, 1 case of HIV infections acquired the virus through heterosexual contact, 1 case through homosexual contact, and in 3 cases the way of transmission was indeterminate due to insufficient information. During this quarter, 3 cases of AIDS were also declared.
