

HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO
Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics
(July – Sept., 2014)

In the third quarter of 2014, there were reported 14 cases of HIV infections, 10 of which were males and 4 were females.

Of the newly cases reported in this quarter, 11 were local residents and 3 were non-residents. In local residents, 4 cases of HIV infections acquired the virus through heterosexual contact, 6 cases through homosexual contact, and 1 case through bisexual contact; whereas 3 cases in non-residents acquired the virus through heterosexual contact. During this quarter, 6 cases of AIDS were also declared.
