

HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO

Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics (January to March, 2015)

In the first quarter of 2015, there were 8 reported cases of HIV infections, 5 of which were males and 3 were females.

Local residents and non-residents occupied half of the newly reported cases in this quarter respectively. In local residents, 2 cases of HIV infections acquired the virus through heterosexual contact, 1 case through homosexual contact, and the transmission route of 1 case was indeterminate due to insufficient information. In non-residents, 1 case acquired the infection through heterosexual contact, 1 case through blood contact in other countries, and the transmission route of 2 cases were indeterminate due to insufficient information.

During this quarter, 5 cases of AIDS were declared.
