

HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO

Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics (April to June, 2015)

In the second quarter of 2015, there were 6 reported cases of HIV infections, 4 of which were males and 2 were females.

Of the newly reported cases in this quarter, 5 were local residents and 1 was non-resident. In local residents, 2 cases of HIV infections acquired the virus through heterosexual contact, 3 cases through homosexual contact. The non-resident case acquired the infection through homosexual contact.

During this quarter, 1 case of AIDS was declared.
