HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics (July to September, 2015)

In the third quarter of 2015, there were 11 reported cases of HIV infections, 9 of which were males and 2 were females.

Of the newly reported cases in this quarter, 5 were local residents and 6 were non-residents. In local residents, 1 case of HIV infection acquired the virus through heterosexual contact, 1 case through bisexual contact and the other 3 cases through homosexual contact. In non-residents, 4 cases acquired the infection through heterosexual contact, 1 case through injecting drug use and the other case through needle-stick injury in other countries.

During this quarter, 3 cases of AIDS were declared.
