HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN MACAO Quarterly HIV/AIDS Statistics (October to December, 2015)

In the fourth quarter of 2015, there were 14 reported cases of HIV infections, 11 of which were males and 3 were females.

Of the newly reported cases in this quarter, 12 were local residents and 2 were non-residents. In local residents, 5 cases of HIV infection acquired the virus through heterosexual contact, 5 cases through homosexual contact and the transmission route of 2 cases were indeterminate due to insufficient information. In non-residents, 1 case acquired the infection through heterosexual contact and 1 case through homosexual contact.

During this quarter, 6 cases of AIDS were declared.
